



Mystic Daisy

Crochet Flower

Stitched in dramatic silence

Materials

to grow a Mystic Daisy with your hook



- Yarn 50% cotton 50% acrylic (or any cotton blend) approx. 50g in any colour you prefer (flower, leaves and stem)
- Hook 1.5 mm
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch marker
- Florist rod or wooden stick 20-40 cm
- Wire 0.7mm
- Hot glue

and a cup of coffee or tea!

Good to know

A few more instructions

- Difficulty: Easy to Advanced Beginner
- You don't have to use the recommended yarn and crochet hook. Experiment with your favorite yarn or a bigger hook to create a bigger flower while preserving the same proportions.
- Don't worry too much about counting. Mother Nature creates in all sizes and shapes, and so can you. Your flowers will be just as stunning in their own unique way.

Abbreviations:

mr = magic ring

ch = chain

cfh = chains from hook (e.g. 4cfh)

sc = single crochet

ss = slip stitch

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

tr = treble crochet stitch (or triple crochet stitch)

pc = picot stitch (chain 3, 1ss into the first chain)

dc increase = 2 dc in 1 stitch

sk = skip stitch (sk1 = skip 1 stitch)

inc = increase stitch (2sc in 1 stitch)

dec = decrease stitch

f.o. = finish off

Let's start creating!

The pattern

Flower center (make 1):

Row 1: 6sc in mr, 1ss - add marker [6]

Row 2: 6inc [12]

Now, let's continue with the petals.

You may use the classic combination: yellow for the center and white for the petals but feel free to experiment, this daisy is stunning in almost all colours.



The pattern

Flower petals

Continue from the previous row, adding a different colour of yarn for the petals.

So, let's create the first petal: [12]

Row 3: 1ss on base, 6ch [6]

Other side: 3sc in 1st, 4sc, 1ss [6]

On yellow center: 1ss on first stitch in base, 1ss.

Second petal: 6ch, other side: as in 1st petal: 3sc in 1st, 4sc, 1ss [6], 1ss on first stitch in base, 1ss.

Repeat this sequence until you have 6 petals in total.

Row 4: Add wire and continue with single crochets around each petal while the first and last stitch of each petal is 1ss. After each petal, continue with the 2ss on base.

So, for each petal you make:

Side 1: 5sc, 1ss

Side 2: 5sc, 1ss

On base: 2ss

Repeat this sequence around all petals until you finish the entire flower.

The pattern

Leaves - small

(make 1)

Use green yarn:

Row 1: 15ch

Other side: ad wire, 2cfh, 14sc

Row 2: [2sc, 3ch] repeat all around the leaf,
f.o.



Assembly

- Attach the flower to the rod with glue and start wrapping the flower and the rod with yarn in the same color as the leaf. About 6–7 cm below the flower, attach the leaf.
- Keep wrapping and gluing until you reach the bottom of the rod.

Congratulations!
